



Placemarks

1. Choose Placemark from Add menu or Placemark tool.
2. Move placemark icon over the area you are identifying
3. Type name of location
4. Choose icon
5. Write description (can use HTML code)
6. Click on "OK" to save to "Create in" location within Google Earth.

Advanced checkbox allows fine tuning of Style (colors), Location and View.

Use the Measurement Tool (Tools menu) to determine the length of line or path.

Choose Path tab to measure distances in multiple segments. Click on the start location. Use the navigation tools to view the end of the first segment and click. Continue clicking until the path is complete. The Path tool is easier to use than the Line tool even for single segments.
