1	Personal Narrative	Write about an activity the class did together. Include the events in the order in which they happened and use words such as my, us, and we. Tell what you and your classmates did and how you felt.
2	Story	<b>Write a story with a person or animal as the main character. Introduce the character in the beginning. Tell what the character does in the middle. End with a sentence that makes the story interesting and complete.</b>
3	Description	Write a description of a person, place, or thing. Include details that will help readers paint a picture of the person, place, or thing in their minds. Also include details that describe what something looks like, sounds like, or feels like.
4	Persuasive Book Report	Write a book report. Choose a book you enjoyed. Tell why you liked it. Persuade others to read the book, too.
5	How-to Article	<b>Write a how-to article to teach other children how to do or make something. Children will write all the steps in order and make the order clear by using numbers or words such as <i>first</i>, <i>next</i>, and <i>last</i>.</b>
6	Report	<b>Write a report about a place you would like to visit. Do research to learn facts about the place. Tell why it is an interesting place.</b>
