Unit (week six)	Mode	Topics
1	Personal Narrative	Write about a time when someone helped you. Be sure to tell how you felt before and after you got help. Remember to tell the event in order.
2	How To Article	Write a how-to article about how to take care of something. Give steps in the right order. Use details to help the reader follow the steps.
3	Persuasive Letter	Think of something you would like your community to change or do. Write a letter to convince people you are right. Include facts and opinions and remember to use your opinion words in your letter.
4	Expository	Write about a topic that has something to do with the earth, ocean, or sky. Think of the main idea you want to share about your topic. Think of details that tell more about the main idea. Remember to use your own words to summarize the facts and details you find.
5	Realistic Fiction	Write a story about a character that has a problem and then solves it. Remember that your story should have a clean beginning, middle and end.
6	Compare/contrast article	Write an article that compares/contrasts 2 objects or people. You may want to write about your 2 favorite foods or your 2 closest friends. Write the facts in an order that makes sense. Use compare/contrast words to make your meaning clear.
